TITLE: NOAH'S FAITH PROFILE

TEXT: Hebrews 11:7

By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.

INTRODUCTION

Like Enoch before him, Noah's profile of faith is remarkable. We can learn a lot from his walk with God. The similarity of the challenges facing his generation with ours makes this text even more relevant. Don't miss out!

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION & REFLECTION

1. Who was Noah? Where in Genesis do we find his story?
2. What does the phrase "by faith" mean? What can we learn from its repetition in Hebrews 11?
3. What was the warning Noah received? Why did God warn Noah and his generation? See Genesis 6:5-13.
4. How did Noah respond to the warning?
5. Are there warnings we too must heed today? Can you give examples? How should we respond?
6. What was the purpose of the ark? Who benefitted from it? Who should also benefit from our walk with Christ today? Compare Acts 16:31.
7. Who built the ark? Who designed the ark? Who prepares our "ark of salvation" today? Whose design? See Matthew 16:18; John 14:2-3
8. How should we prepare for Judgment Day and the Second Coming? See Matthew 25:13.
