**TITLE: ABRAHAM'S FAITH PROFILE (1)**

**TEXT: Hebrews 11:8-10**

*8 By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. 9 By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise; 10 for he waited for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker is God. Hebrews 11: 8-10*

### INTRODUCTION

This week we study Abraham's Faith Profile. Comparing Scripture with Scripture, there are great lessons we learn from Abraham's faith that are applicable in our day-to-day life. Please also read Genesis 12:1-4 and Revelation 21:2-18.

### QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION & REFLECTION

1. What did God call Abraham to do?
2. Is it possible that God can call us today to experiences, territories, areas, ministries and assignments we don't know yet?
3. According to Hebrews 11:8, how did Abraham respond? How should we respond to the call of God?
4. What was Abraham's life and status in Haran (Genesis 12:4) that he could have used as an excuse not to go where God was calling him? What might sound like reasonable excuses or grounds for not obeying God in your situation today?
5. What did God promise Abraham? What has God promised us? What is the link between faith and the promises?
6. What does it mean that Abraham lived in tents as a pilgrim? What should be our attitude as we sojourn in this life?
7. According to Hebrews 11:10, what was Abraham's hope? What does the Bible tell us about that awesome city (Hebrews 11:10; Rev 3:12; 21:2-18)?
8. How vivid is your expectation of our eternal destiny through Christ?
