TITLE: SARAH'S FAITH PROFILE

TEXT: Hebrews 11:11-12

¹¹ By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised. ¹² Therefore from one man, and him as good as dead, were born as many as the stars of the sky in multitude – innumerable as the sand which is by the seashore. Hebrews 11: 11-12

INTRODUCTION

This week we study faith through the lens of Sarah's life. There are invaluable lessons to learn from this great matriarch. Compare also Mark 4:3-20 and Genesis 16.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION & REFLECTION

- 1. According to Romans 15:4, what do we gain from studying biblical characters?
- 2. According to Hebrews 11:11, how did having faith benefit Sarah?
- 3. Why did she need to receive strength in order to conceive seed?
- 4. According to Mark 4:14, what seed should our hearts conceive?
- 5. In light of the Parable of the Soils (Mark 4:3-20), is receptivity automatic? What hinders spiritual conception?
- 6. In view of Sarah's example, how can the receptivity of our "spiritual wombs" (hearts) be renovated?
- 7. How important is our judgment (understanding) of God's faithfulness? (See Heb. 11:11b)
- 8. How did Sarah's breakthrough benefit Abraham's destiny? (Heb. 11:12)
- 9. Why wasn't Sarah's "plan B" (Hagar) acceptable before God? (See Genesis 16; 17:17-22)
- 10. Are you also sometimes tempted to settle for the "permissive" will rather than the "perfect" will of God? What should you do?
